 2 Medical Emergency Team (MET) / Rapid Response Team (RRT) may also be called by other names, such as Medical Evaluation Team, Medical Emergency Response Team, Critical Care Outreach Team, and Condition Critical Team. An assigned team that often consists of a nurse and physician with critical care/emergency background, and a respiratory care practitioner. The team is called for a clinical crisis when certain objective criteria are met so that appropriate care can be delivered, often preventing respiratory or cardiac arrest.

 4 ICU = all critical care units, including coronary care. (Excluded are PACU beds used for ICU).
